This is not a treatment planning service, as the ability for delegates to treatment plan cases correctly is one of the main objectives of the exam. We will review the information provided and give you our view as to whether this is a suitable case to attempt for accreditation.

This will not be a guarantee of success if we have recommended that you complete the case and submit it. However, anyone who has submitted a case type for examination will know how much work is involved and our aim is to give you a good starting point. Success will be determined by your case report, the standard of photography and the standard of the finished case.
